



Painted Surface Cleaning Instructions

Please note that not all dirt is alike and cleaning it from painted surfaces takes a bit of skill. For example, drywall dust and other similar construction debris can act like an abrasive. If this debris is rubbed off, it can cause surface abrasions. It is better to dust off or blow off, using compressed air, any accumulations prior to cleaning the painted surface.

Once the painted surface is free of construction debris, use soft cloth and a mixture of water and mild dish soap or non-abrasive cleaner like Windex. Do not use any abrasive or acidic cleaners or cloths as these will remove or damage the paint finish.
